## SECTION MEETING DECEMBER 6-9, 1988 PHOENIX, ARIZONA

The annual Section meeting will be held in Phoenix, Arizona, December 6-9, 1988. Dr. Harold L. ReKate will host the meeting. The site will be the luxurious Camelback Inn Resort and Golf Club in Scottsdale, Arizona. This is a beautiful hotel in a superb location. This time of the year we expect good weather with temperatures between the 60's and 70's during the day dropping to the 40's at night. The meeting will begin Tuesday evening from 6:00 - 8:30 with the welcoming cocktail party. The scientific sessions will begin on Wednesday. There will be a continental breakfast at 6:30 a.m. with the welcoming speech at 7:10 a.m. Dr. Joseph Volpe will give the Paolo Raimondi Memorial Lecture and his topic will be Positron Emission Tomography in the Study of the Premature's Brain. The morning session will end by 1:00 p.m. and there will be an afternoon golf tournament for those who wish to participate. On Thursday, again, the meeting will begin early and papers will end by 12:30 p.m. at which time the business meeting will take place. On Thursday afternoon, there will be a tennis tournament arranged again for those who wish to participate. The reception will be held at 6:30 Thursday evening followed by the annual banquet. The meeting adjourns at 1:00 p.m. Friday afternoon. Excellent quality abstracts have been submitted and the meeting should be exceptional. If you have not already, make plans to attend!

## MINUTES OF THE BUSINESS MEETING TORONTO, APRIL 26, 1988

The meeting was called to order at 5:20 p.m. by David McLone. There were 24 members of the Section in attendance. The minutes of the previous meeting circulated in *Short Cuts* were approved as read. The report of the secretary-treasurer, Michael Scott, was then given, indicating that there was a positive cash in-flow over the past fiscal year of approximately \$3,500. The total fund balance in the Section's accounts was approximately \$92,400, roughly \$2,000 less than at the close of the fiscal year one year previously. Despite heavy meeting expenses,

revenues from meeting registration and exhibitors covered all expenses. It was recommended by the Executive Council that the present dues structure of \$50 per year be continued for the next fiscal year.


The report of the Membership Committee, chaired by Hal ReKate was then given. The Committee recommended that Robert Beatty, Edward Benzel, Dudley Davis, Parker Mickle, German Montoya, and Ronald Ucinski be approved for membership in the Section, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Dr. ReKate also gave the interim program committee report, indicating that the Section meeting would take place in Scottsdale, Arizona at the Camelback Inn, December 6-9, with an opening reception the evening of December 6. The daily schedule would be adjusted so as to have the scientific meetings from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., leaving the afternoon free for outdoor activities, golf, tennis, etc. All members were urged to request their residents to submit papers for the Shulman Award, a prize that was vigorously competed for in 1987.

There were no new officers to be elected, but Dr. McLone announced that he would appoint a historian for the Section in order to maintain the archives and other important historical data related to the Section's formation.

There being no further new business, the meeting was adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
